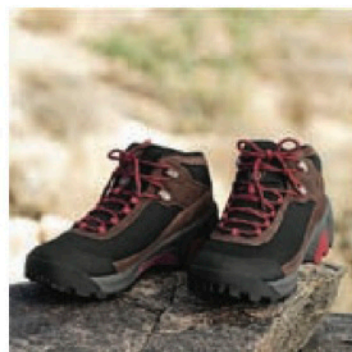


Mountain Hardwear
